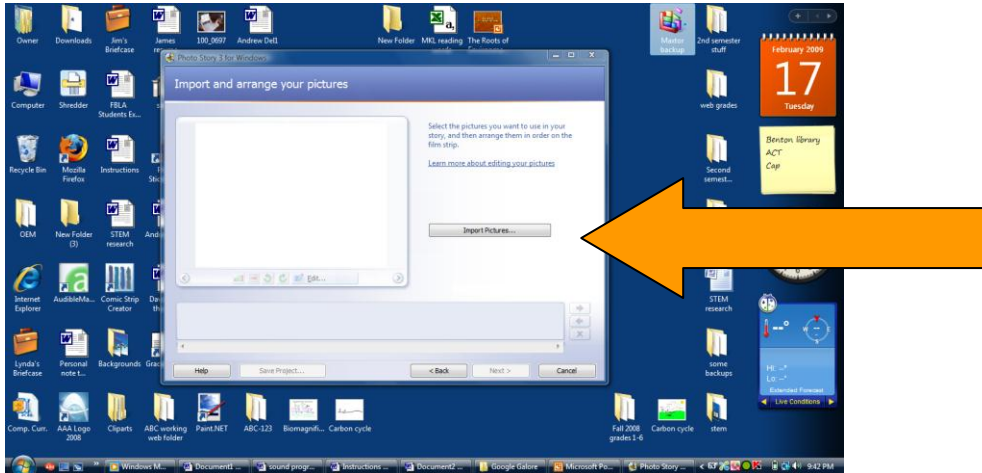


Photo Story 3

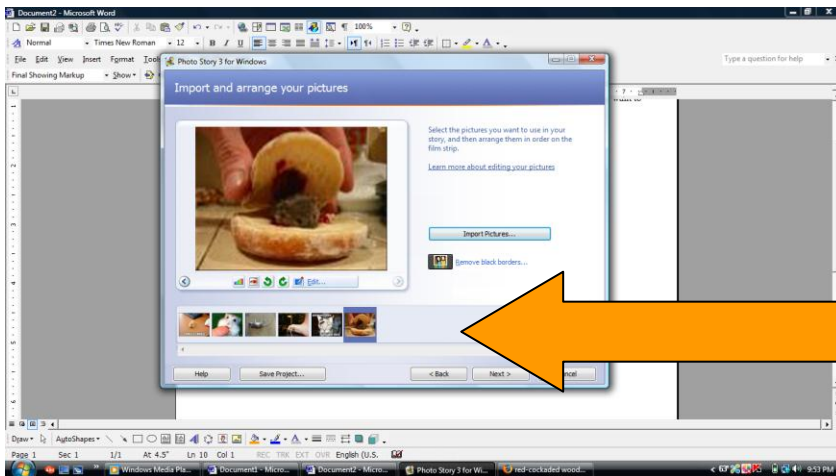

First, you'll need to have some pictures ready. Then click on Import Pictures.



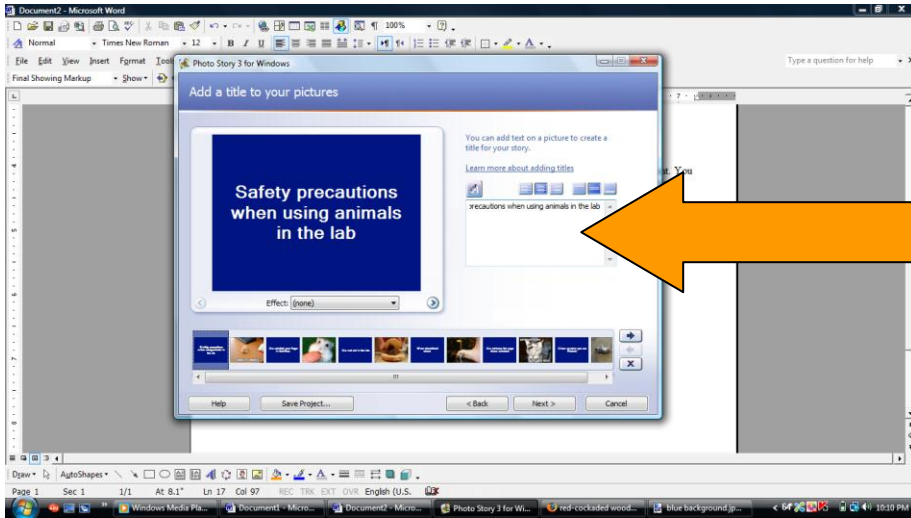
Import the pictures you want to use.

The storyboard is across the bottom. You can click and drag pictures to get them in the order you want. You can not make copies within Photo Story. If you need more than one of the same picture, import it twice.



Click next.

If you want text, type it in here. You can change the font, position etc. by the buttons on top.



Do this for all the slides you want text on. Then click NEXT.

You can type in notes for your own use for when showing the slide show later. Also, this is where you can record your speech. Click the button with the round red dot and start speaking. Click the button with the square red dot to stop recording. Do this for each slide. Click on PREVIEW if you want to here how it sounds before moving on.

Do not click on NEXT yet. Instead, click on the CUSTOMIZE MOTION button if you want to set different motion functions. There are two tabs, one for changing direction and motion and one for transitions. If you want to start in one spot and back out as you enlarge the screen then follow these instructions:

1. Check the box at the upper left corner that says; SPECIFY START AND END POSITON
2. The left picture is the starting point. Adjust the inner box by pulling on a corner to set just the part you want at the beginning. If you click, hold and drag the inner box you can shift it anywhere you want.
3. Do the same with the right picture but this time you need to set the inner box to the finished position.

Click “Next” when finished.

Now it’s time to add background music or your own voice recording if you want. If not, just click “Next” There is some pre-imported music that you can use free. Be careful with copyrights if the song isn’t one you purchased yourself. I like to use Garageband.com. They have lots of free music downloads and it is searchable by genres.

Click “Next”.

Highlight how you want to save it (probably the first one) and then click “Finish”.
